BOYS: Neat shirt/slacks; ties and jackets are optional:




GIRLS: Dresses or slacks of any color:



Seating is reserved for immediate families, parents & siblings of the children receiving First Communion. There are a maximum of 4 families per liturgy; in some instances you may be the only family for the Mass – *Please inform the Religious Formation office of any priority seating for those with disabilities.* Be at least 15 minutes early to receive the appropriate instructions. ALL should take special care to practice reverent and prayerful reception of Eucharist (head bow/Amen). Eucharist is offered under both species of bread and wine, which is full participation. Parents should discuss and choose beforehand how they wish their child to receive.



Please remind visiting relatives to be mindful that we are celebrating a Sacrament and to maintain the prayerful atmosphere, - photos should be taken with minimal interruption to the liturgy - The Presider will be available after the liturgy for any photos.
