

## Things to Know:

- Child should wear medal received at the *Remember The Story* celebration
- Arrive 15 MINUTES BEFORE the liturgy
- Check in with presider (priest) for instructions
- Child and parents will join the entrance procession (siblings welcome to process in or be in seats)
- Seats will be reserved for immediate family (child, siblings, parents) only
- Please notify the Religious Formation office **at least one week** before your scheduled liturgy if there are any special needs (i.e. wheelchair) for immediate family and/or relatives attending
- NO PHOTOGRAPHY during the liturgy, please. The presider will be available for photos after the liturgy. Video from the balcony only.
- Children, with immediate family, will be first to receive Communion, from the presider; therefore it is essential that you arrive in time for instructions
- As mentioned at the parent meeting, the current practice for reception of Holy Communion is a slight head bow prior to receiving both Bread and Wine. After the head bow, approach the priest, hold out the hands, hand over hand, palms up, to receive. Our parish recommends the full reception, both bread and wine, understanding that wine is a parental choice. If you choose to have your child receive from the cup, please be sure she/he has tasted wine prior to receiving. Parents who are not receiving Communion should still accompany their family but not put out their hands to receive.
