Music is of vital importance in your wedding liturgy. The music chosen must be liturgically appropriate and should encourage the participation of the assembly.

Tom Kendzia and or Justin Dery, Music Directors, will meet with you to review music for your special day. Whether in person or on Zoom, time and date can be accommodated for meeting time.

The stipend for our parish wedding musician is \$275. You may also choose to have a cantor at a stipend of \$150 and/or an instrumentalist (flute, trumpet, violin) for a stipend of \$150. The music directors will provide recommendations and scheduling for cantors and instrumentalists.
